

SPRING

Spring in the Great North Woods and Northeast Kingdom welcomes the most beautiful change!

Spring in North Country brings bluebird skies as well as an opportunity to enjoy winter activities longer than any place in New Hampshire. We welcome the change of season a little later than most in New England, setting a perfect stomping ground for those that love the snow but not the biting cold of mid-winter. Ride your sled well into April and possibly even May, where elevations maintain several feet of snow and the valleys start to welcome the signs of spring. Maintain tradition with a visit to a sugar house when the sap is running. What a beautiful contrast to experience!

The warming weather welcomes back all of those critters we were missing, and also gives new and fresh scenery for Moose watching in New Hampshire. New Hampshire wildlife sightings are one of a kind, and to capture them in the freshness of spring is even better when witnessed in the Great North Woods!

SPRING

ATV'ing

Early-to-mid spring is considered “mud season,” where the ice melts, the ground thaws, and many of our roads and trails become mud swamps, which are unsafe for travel. But this changes when Memorial Day Weekend comes around and over a thousand miles of ATV trails open up for everyone’s riding pleasure! ATV’ing in the Great North is one of our most cherished pastimes, for it offers an unparalleled, thrilling experience thanks to help from local clubs and volunteers. The region’s trails weave through vast wilderness, providing ATV riders with breathtaking views of mountains, fields, forests and waterways. It’s the perfect way to explore all that the North Country has to offer, especially in the late spring.

Wildlife

When the weather warms up around May, a wealth of flora and fauna come out of hiding. Our 300 plus species of wildlife that populate the region make any activity a Wildlife Adventure! The vegetation here most closely resembles that of the northern Appalachian Mountains interspersed with elements of the boreal forest to the north. This is especially apparent in our variety of songbirds.

This is also a fantastic time to spot our most famous resident: the Moose! Calves are born in the spring, so don’t be surprised if you see mothers with their little ones. The calves usually stay with their mothers until the next calf is born the following year.



Fishing

Home to a magnificent collection of pristine lakes, ponds and rivers—all managed to perfection—the North Country offers anglers some of the very best fly fishing in the eastern United States. The region's waters provide an ideal environment for native brook trout, rainbows and brown trout, and even species of landlocked salmon, all to make Fishing in the Great North Woods unlike any other fishing spot in the Northeast! Spring landlocked salmon & trout fishing typically starts just after ice out when smelt start to spawn, which is typically early May.



The ***"Trophy Stretch" of the Connecticut River*** is a must for those wanting to experience fly fishing in the North Country. 2.5 miles of pocket water, riffles, and pools provides some of northern New England's best trout and salmon fishing.

2024 Total Solar Eclipse: A Once-in-a-Lifetime Event

A total solar eclipse happens when the Moon passes directly between the Sun and Earth, completely blocking the face of the Sun and darkening the sky as if it were dawn or dusk. Because the path of the Moon's shadow is so narrow during this already-uncommon event, the chance of seeing one in your area and lifetime is extremely low.

That being said, we are beyond thrilled to share that the path of the 2024 eclipse will sweep *directly* through the North Country!

The Great North American Eclipse will kick off the 2024 spring season on April 8th, passing through parts of Mexico, the USA and Canada... and that includes right here in Northern New England! Join us to witness this cosmic event that you may otherwise never see again. If you plan on visiting, be sure to come prepared—April still has wintry temperatures!



WATERFALLS & BRIDGES

Waterfalls

Along scenic roadways, tucked away on a dirt road, or a short hike into the forest, you will find beautiful waterfalls and cascades. These natural wonders are scattered throughout the North Country and provide a great place to relax and explore.

BEAVER BROOK FALLS: Located in Colebrook, NH. Dip your toes in the water, have a picnic, and hike to the top. Take Route 145 north for 2.4 miles. The falls will be on the right with ample parking. It's even located on the ATV trails.

GARFIELD FALLS: Located in Pittsburg, NH. Take Rte 3 to Magalloway Road. Drive 13 miles on Magalloway, look for the kiosk on the left across from an outhouse. It is about 1/4 mile hike down to the falls. The trail is to the left of the kiosk.



THE HUNTINGTON CASCADES: Located in Dixville, NH. From Colebrook, drive 10 miles east on Rte. 26. The parking lot will be on the right, past the Balsams and Dixville Notch. The trail follows the brook to a series of beautiful cascades extending nearly a mile.

LITTLE HELLGATE FALLS: Located in Pittsburg, NH. Named "Hellgate" because many a logger lost his life here breaking up log jams. Drive north on Rte 3 to Magalloway Road. Take Buckhorn Road which is the second right off Magalloway Road. You will pass through a gate after 3-4 miles and the road becomes Cedar Stream Road. Look for snowmobile trail #137 on the left. Park on the side and hike down the snowmobile trail, crossing 2 snowmobile bridges. The trailhead is located immediately after crossing the second bridge. It's very steep!

Columbia Covered Bridge

Located in Columbia, NH, 4 miles south of Colebrook village on Columbia Bridge Rd.

Bacon Road Covered Bridge/Pittsburg-Clarksville Bridge

Located off Rte 3 in Pittsburg village on Bacon Road.

River Road Covered Bridge

Located in Pittsburg, 1 mile east on River Road, 7 miles north of town.

Happy Corner Covered Bridge/Perry Stream Bridge

Located in Pittsburg off Rte 3 on Hill Rd, 6 miles north of town.







Camping

SUMMER

Paddling

The North Country is home to many beautiful large lakes and rivers, which are a perfect paddler's paradise. The bodies of water along East Inlet are just one of many popular sites for paddling adventures. A North Country paddle rewards paddlers with great fishing, mountain vistas, and plenty of peace and solitude.

DAY 1: Put in at Arlin Brook, unmarked access across the road from the visitor center on Rte 3. Paddle about 4.25 miles through quick water to Holbrook Point, a campsite with room for about 3 tents.

DAY 2: Paddle 14 miles to Lyman Falls, which has several primitive campsites, and access to some of the finest trout fishing in the area.

DAY 3: Paddle 3 miles south to Bloomfield. If you need food or supplies, make sure to stop at DeBanville's General Store. Paddle an additional 11 miles to a takeout just past the Maidstone Bridge. You'll find a timber staircase on the New Hampshire side. Tip: The Northern Forest Canoe Trail's Maine Central Railroad Trestle Campsite makes a good resting point/lunch spot; it is about 7 miles below Bloomfield.



Moose Tracks & Tips

"Moose Alley" in Pittsburg is one of the most popular places to see a moose in the North Country. It is located on Rte 3 in Pittsburg, north of the village.

Rte 26 from Dixville Notch to Errol, NH is a stretch of roadway where moose are commonly seen. Keep your eyes peeled for muddy bogs and swampland, where they tend to hang out.

Driving the **"13 mile woods"** on Rte 16 from Errol to Milan is another great opportunity to see moose by the Androscoggin River.

Traveling along the quiet **Rte 114** from Canaan to Norton, VT is another option to see them as well.

Silvio Conte Nulhegan Basin on Rte 105 in Brunswick, VT has over 150,000 acres perfect for moose sightings & wildlife watching.

DO NOT FEED OR APPROACH MOOSE!

They are wild animals and should be enjoyed from a distance.

BE PATIENT!

You improve your chances of seeing a moose by slowing down and looking around.

Moose are MOSTLY ACTIVE AT NIGHT, but can be seen any time of the day.

BRAKE FOR MOOSE!

Due to their height and coloring, they do not show up well at night.



ARTS & CULTURE

GREAT NORTH WOODS CENTER FOR THE ARTS

The Great North Woods Center for the Arts offers indoor and outdoor performance spaces for concerts, plays, art shows, arts and crafts events, and other community gatherings. The Center is also the home of the three major North Country arts groups: the Great North Woods Committee for the Arts, the Connecticut River Artisans Group, and the Carriage Lane Players.

TILLOTSON CENTER

The Tillotson Center features a 171-seat theater for concerts, plays, movies, dances, and other events and art gallery. It also is home to the Colebrook Historical Society's annex museum in the basement.

WEATHERVANE

Whitefield, NH has been home to the Weathervane since its founding in 1966. Located on Route 3 (Lancaster Road), the 250-seat capacity auditorium has no obstructed view and is arranged in tiered seating. Weathervane's performance signature is presenting eleven Main-stage productions in 15 weeks, scheduled in alternating repertory with a core company of resident professional actors. These new productions of Broadway's best—both classic and contemporary—alternate Monday through Saturday late June through August, and Tuesday through Sunday in September and October. Weathervane also hosts family-friendly children's programming Tuesdays and Fridays in the summer as well as an intensive theatre camp in August.

in the North Country!**

Get ready for autumn hikes, ATV'ing, hunting, and more in the Great North Woods!

It's no secret that our Great North Country of New Hampshire and Vermont is home to some of the most dazzling fall colors found anywhere in the world. Fall up here brings crisp days packed with brilliant displays of color, changing the landscape to a kaleidoscope of red, orange and yellow. People travel here from around the world to experience the spectacular foliage. Go North to absorb Mother Nature's extravagant display of color, with virtually NO traffic to deter the viewing. Fall means spectacular views without the crowds; you can experience the changing colors in peace and quiet. Mid-September to mid-October is referred to as our peak "leaf peeping," and some of our favorite spots for leaf-peeping can be found right here.

This season invites you to enjoy familiar outdoor activities such as hiking, biking, fishing, and ATV'ing surrounded by color and crisp air. But in addition, this time of year is popular for hunting, moose-spotting, and even a family favorite past time: apple picking!

And, it's not too late to join the **Go North 9er Hiking Challenge** (see page 9) if you haven't yet; in fact, fall is our favorite season to climb any or all of the nine peaks in northern New Hampshire and Vermont! The fiery foliage makes the view from the top that much more rewarding, and the cooler temperatures keep things more comfortable, even when the hike is more strenuous. Hiking & Biking

Hiking in the fall is an unforgettable experience, as you are able to immerse yourself in brilliant color displays like no other. For the best colors, plan a hiking trip around late-September or early-October. Spectacular views can be found along the mighty **Cohos Trail System**, which travels from Pittsburg to the Connecticut Lake State Forest, up to the Canadian border. And, early-to-mid fall is your last chance before the snow hits to get your biking in. In New Hampshire, a unique conservation easement was put in place in our northernmost town Pittsburg, resulting in an abundance in many beautiful biking trails. FALL

Wildlife

On your fall hike, bike or ATV adventure, be sure to watch for wildlife before many of our critters hibernate for the winter. The rugged, mountainous terrain provides ideal habitat for northern whitetail deer, as well as bird species like grouse, woodcock and pheasant.

As for our beloved moose, breeding or rutting season lasts from September through October. During this time, the bulls can be aggressive and the cows are easily agitated. Therefore, viewing from your vehicle at a distance is the least stressful to the moose and the safest for all.

Best Upland Bird & Big Game Deer Hunting in New England

Our abundant wildlife also makes great game for hunting! Hunters visit the North Country every year in hopes of bagging their limit. New Hampshire and Vermont provide hundreds of thousands of acres of dense spruce forests giving way to areas of clearcut woods. Ample mountain streams, high mountain bogs and the fertile river valleys are all accessible.

Whether you prefer hunting birds like grouse, woodcock and pheasant or big game like large whitetail deer and even black bear or moose, you'll find the North Country's abundant wildlife and miles of rugged wilderness make it one of the premier hunting destinations in the Northeast. WINTER


